BUMP OUT: Sunday 21nd NOVEMBER from **6pm -12 midnight** and Monday 22nd **8am-11am**

**** ALL DISPLAYS MUST BE OUT BY 12 NOON Monday OR ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL APPLY ****

TROPHIES, MERCHANDISE AND PRIZE MONEY:

Trophies, merchandise and prize money to an approximate value of \$30,000 will be distributed among entrants. The time, date and relevant details regarding trophy presentations will be given in a later advice sheet.

ENTRY FEE:

Entry Fee is \$60 incl GST. Completed entry form, entry fee, judging fee (if applicable) and current photo of the vehicle are to be forwarded to the Show Manager, Queensland Hot Rod Association Ltd., P.O. Box 217, Coorparoo, QLD, 4151. All Entrants will receive a goodies bag, an event T shirt and a numbered commemorative Number plate.

JUDGING:

Bonnet, boot and doors must be unlocked. Anything which is not accessible to the judges will not be judged. If access is unorthodox, please advise the Stewards prior to judging.

To meet increased costs, a fee of \$11 incl GST will be charged for each vehicle required to be judged

PHOTOGRAPHS:

A current photograph/image of reasonable quality must accompany each entry. Please note that photos will not be returned and the Show Promoters reserve the right to use the photos/images as they require.

*****Entries received without a photo/image supplied will not be accepted *****

REJECTION OF ENTRY:

The Queensland Hot Rod Association retains the right to reject any entry without assigning a reason and the entry fee will be refunded **at the conclusion of the Show.**

CLOSING DATES FOR ENTRIES:

Entries close with the last mail 30th September 2010. Entries received post marked after this date will be treated as late entries. The late entry fee will be an additional fee of \$50.00 and late entry fees will not be refunded. **Please Note: These dates and fees will be strictly enforced.**

WITHDRAWALS:

Any person wishing to withdraw an entry should do so in writing and if received prior to 30th September 2010 the entry fee will be refunded **at the conclusion of the Show** less 10% of the entry fee for administration costs. Any cancellation after this date and prior to the Show will incur a penalty of 60% of the entry fee.

CLUB STAND AWARDS:

Club stand awards will be presented as follows:-

- 1st \$1500.00 Award plus Trophy.
- 2nd \$750.00 Award.
- 3rd \$350.00 Award.

Note: To be eligible for this award the club stands must meet the minimum requirements as set by the Promoter.

PLEASE NOTE: Club Stands require a minimum of three (3) vehicles to be eligible. There will be a limit of six (6) vehicles per stand. Clubs wishing to display more than six (6) vehicles may be accepted at the discretion of the show committee NB: ALL CLUB DISPLAYS ARE SUBJECT TO AVAILABLE SPACE

In the event of club stands and or individual stands not meeting the minimum standards, Australian Street Rod Federation Stewards may rule no 2nd or 3rd placing to be awarded. In this event, the prize money for the awards not made will be re-allocated as follows:

1st placing only: \$2,600.00, or 1st and 2nd placing only: 1st \$1650.00, 2nd \$950.00.

SUBSTITUTE VEHICLES ON CLUB STANDS ONLY:

Cars on club stands *may* be substituted by other club cars up to 30th September 2010. After 30th September 2010 any substitute will be required to pay the late entry deposit of \$50.00. Substitute vehicles for club stands will only be accepted providing the number of entries on the relevant club stand have been entered and paid for by the closing date of 30th September 2010. QHRP must be notified in writing of substitute vehicles and be accompanied by an official entry form, relevant deposit and a current photograph.

STAND PRESENTATION:

The 2010 QLD HOT ROD & STREET MACHINE SPECTACULAR is the ASRF QLD State Titles and therefore entrants are required to display their vehicle in a professional manner. While the mode of exhibition is left entirely to individual choice, artistic and attractive displays designed to enhance the vehicle are highly recommended.

All plant, machinery and exhibits must comply with statutory requirements of Safety.

Minimum requirements are:

- a) Some form of floor covering. The use of polystyrene bubbles is strictly forbidden and excessive use of black garden plastic should be avoided.
- b) A strong crowd barrier.
- c) A sign giving details of the vehicle.
- d) Accent and display lighting is recommended but optional.

NOTE: Any display using *SAND, GRAVEL, DIRT OR BARK* etc., must have plastic sheeting underneath and a *BORDER*, a minimum of 100mm in height, around the display to hold back covering material.

Anyone using material which may cause dust is advised to be considerate of others during set-up. Individual and club stand presentation must meet the minimum requirements set by the promoter. This also includes full utilization of requested stand space by individuals or clubs, i.e. full number of originally entered vehicles. Any dispute regarding a club or individual stand not meeting the required standard or correct number of vehicles will be mediated by a joint committee from the ASRF Stewards and the QHRP Show Committee. Boundary fences must not exceed one metre in height.

No screws, nails etc are to be fixed to any walls, posts or floors in the GCCEC buildings. All electrical leads used must be tagged and **MUST NOT** be ran across walkways. Entrants shall not exchange stands or sub-let all or any portion of such stand without prior approval of the Show Manager.

***** As in previous years electricity is included at no cost to the trader or entrant *****

RULES, REGULATIONS AND CLASSIFICATIONS:

All rules, specifications and classifications pertaining to the 42th QLD State Title Hot Rod Show for ASRF class vehicles are laid out in the Australian Street Rod Federation Handbook. Enquiries regarding this handbook should be made to the ASRF QLD Divisional Council. Attention Mr. Colin Chapman.

CLASSIFICATION:

All classes are dependent upon sufficient numbers of entries and sections may be expanded or combined according to the entries received. ***To be eligible for Street Rod, Street Machine or Custom classes, a vehicle must be driven a minimum of 50 metres into the show facility; this is to be witnessed by a Steward or Show Official.***

- **CURRENT REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST ACCOMPANY THE VEHICLE INTO THE GCCEC.**

Competition Class is only for ANDRA and CAMS class vehicles issued with a current log book.

***** All classes will be verified by ASRF and/or ASMF Stewards *****

NOTE: Classification of vehicles are set and laid out in the ASRF and/or ASMF Rule Books

THE CLASSIFICATIONS ARE SET BY THE ASRF and/or ASMF AND NOT THE PROMOTER.

INSURANCE:

Entrants shall not in any way do anything which would prejudice the Fire Insurance Risk on the buildings and shall provide at their expense fire extinguishers as considered necessary by the Fire Brigade Inspectors.

The Committee and/or QHRP accepts no responsibility for the insurance or otherwise of exhibits against loss or damage, and shall not be liable for loss by fire, theft, riot, accident or other causes, and the entrant hereby undertakes to keep QHRP indemnified against all claims whatsoever and howsoever arising out of erection, display or dismantling of exhibits, also without affecting the generality of the above in respect to:

- a) Any action which may be taken by the GCCEC or other authority with regard to the removal, alterations or rejection of any stand, structure or exhibit, and no liability shall attach to the Committee or QHRP in respect to any such action.
- b) Any claims made by the GCCEC or other authority to cover damage to its property by the entrant, his/her servants or agents or contractors.
- c) Any claim made by any person for injury or loss arising out of or connected with any exhibits or the display, use, erection or dismantling of the same.

CARS FOR SALE:

The Queensland Hot Rod Association will provide the only 'FOR SALE' signs to be used in the Qld Hot Rod Show. The owner will be required to fill in a 'for sale fact sheet' that our Show Office will be able to photocopy and supply to prospective buyers.

This service will be provided at no cost to all entrants EXCEPT late entries. **Late entries will incur a fee of \$10 for this service.** The QHRP reserves the right to reject any 'FOR SALE' car.

The Committee and/or QHRP will not under any circumstances be responsible for any loss to the entrant/exhibitor caused by breakdown or defect of lights, power or any other service or failure in respect of any of the arrangements or for any cause whatsoever. Public Liability Insurance effected by QHRP will cover the legal liability of any entrant. QHRP shall not be liable or deemed to be liable for any loss, damage, theft or injury sustained by an entrant or any employees of an entrant. Entrants shall be responsible for the effectation of Worker's Compensation Insurance in respect of all persons engaged by them.

- **SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS:**
- Covered footwear **MUST** be worn during setup (bump in) and pull down (bump out) periods.
- No Children are permitted during bump in and bump out periods
- Fluoro safety vests must be worn **AT ALL TIMES** during bump in and bump out periods
- No Alcohol is permitted during set up (bump in) and pull down(bump out) periods
